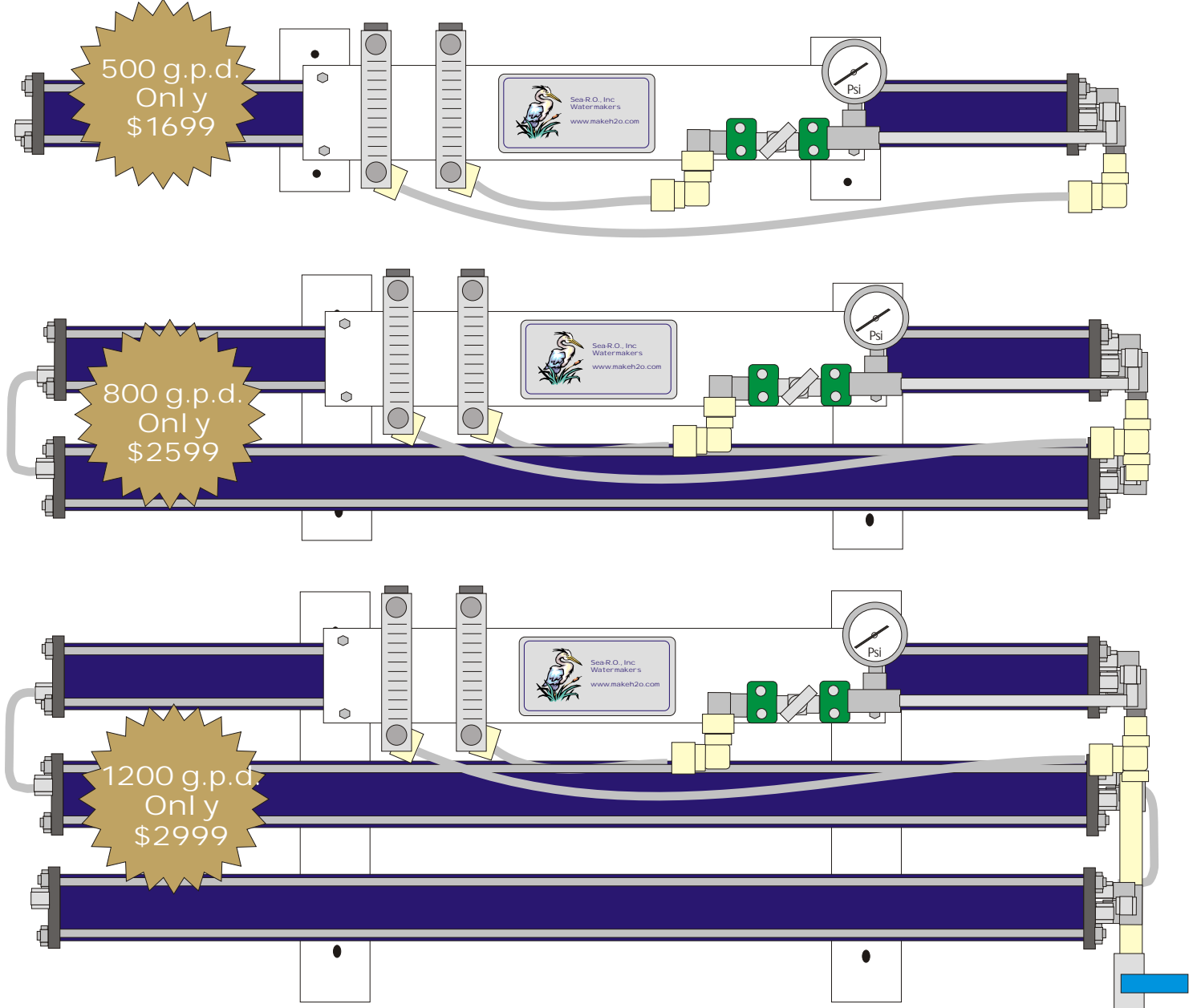

Many times in the past, perfectly good high pressure pumps have been discarded and condemned when other components within the system are beyond repair.

If your existing system has membranes that are no longer producing good water, leaks in the existing pressure vessels or water quality electronics that have failed, the “normal” thing to do is to replace the entire system.

But now, you have an option.

If you have an existing system that uses a 1.5 to 2.0 h.p. pump and motor combination (2.0-2.5 gpm), simply couple this to either the 500 or the 800 gallon per day pressure vessel assembly and you are back in business.

If you have a 3.0 h.p. pump and motor (4.0-4.8 gpm), you can use our 1200 gallon per day assembly.

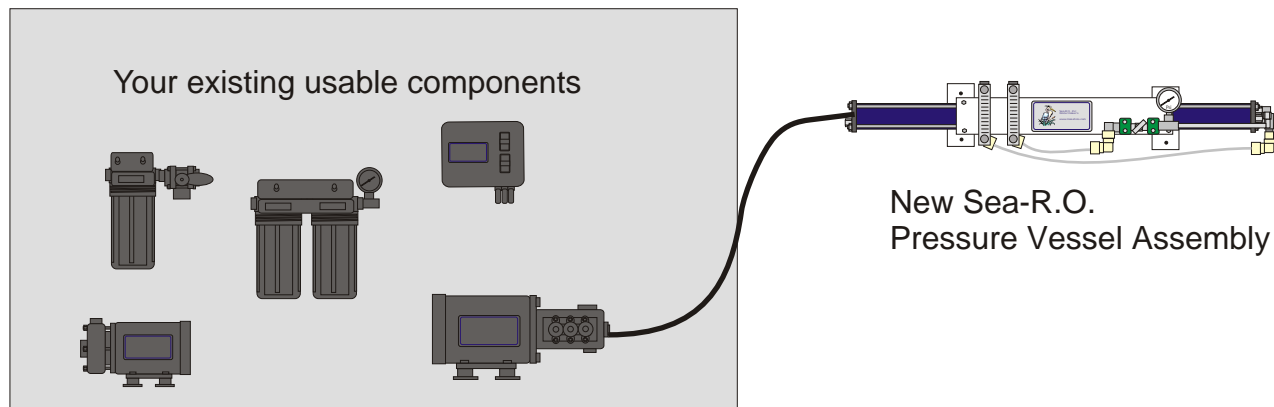
Components you may be able to save and keep installed in your boat include:

Strainer, boost pump, prefilters, high pressure pump, electrical wiring and controls, fresh water flush system, and hose and plumbing to your storage tank and overboard drain.
